## RENEWING THE COOPERATION WITH PASCH/GOETHE

On a Nile boat trip on Thursday 14th October EBIS & Goethe Institute Cairo signed the renewal of the cooperation agreement. The Goethe-Institute Cairo are in charge of 20 schools in Egypt as part of the PASCH initiative. The students and teachers actively participate in local and global activities and are thus part of the global PASCH family. With attractive educational offers, PASCH contributes to the sustainable qualification of both schoolchildren and teachers and thus expands the skills of young people for studying in Germany and in later professional life.
