- ✓ White or Dark Blue Plain Socks

PE Days

- ✓ EBIS Cotton Bottoms (Clean and Ironed)
- ✓ EBIS T-Shirt (Clean and Ironed)
- ✓ White or Black Trainers
- ✓ White or Dark Blue Plain Socks

- ✓ Clean trimmed nails (Girls: no nail polish)
- ✓ Girls: Hair tied up with bobbles or ribbons (white or blue)

Kindly note, that children must only wear their PE uniform on PE days. Formal EBIS uniform is expected to be worn on all other days.
