

## A2 LANGUAGE EXAM

Congratulation to Adham Aly Eldlebs hany, year 9B who passed the Goethe A2 language certificate with 80%. The Goethe A2 language certificate: Fit in Deutsch is a German exam for children and young people between 10 and 16 years of age. It certifies that candidates have acquired basic language skills and corresponds to the second level (A2) on the six-level scale of competence laid down in the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR).

PASSING THE EXAM DEMONSTRATES THAT YOU CAN

- ask and reply to simple questions as well as make and respond to requests,
- write about yourself and others using simple expressions and sentences,
- understand conversations and texts about familiar topics.

## ZOOM WITH SCHOOL FROM BERLIN

For the 5th time the German department is working with the German children radio channel RADIJOJO. This radio channel has been funded by the Federal Government Commissioner for Culture and Media and the Federal Ministry of Family Affairs under the Patronage of German chancellor Dr. Angela Merkel.

In November 2022 we met a German school class from Berlin via Zoom. Our students got in contact with the Berliner students and they worked together on the Radio program. The aim was to over-bridge the national borders and to know & understand each other more. All of them have the chance to discover other cultures. During the zoom meeting the students asked and answered many questions. Our EBIS were so excited and happy at the same time.

# DRAWING COMPETITION BY RADIJOJO

Radijojo in Berlin has been holding international drawing competitions for several years. This time it was again about the 17 goals that the United Nations have decided to achieve by 2030. These include, for example: - that nobody should go hungry anymore, - that all people get a good education, - that the climate is better protected and that all countries should work together to achieve these goals. ## PASCH CHOIR

The PASCH ensemble of the large PASCH choir did not let the corona pandemic stop them from singing. In the past year, the PASCH ensemble has mainly focused on writing their own songs and filming them in music videos. In the autumn of last year, PASCH students and teachers as well as the cooperation partners of the Wolfratshausen Children's and Youth Choir set about reinterpreting the indigenous American song "Silver Birch" and especially new, own parts in German, Arabic and composed in English. The theme of the song should reflect the loneliness caused by Corona, but also the ways in which people connect despite the isolation. The next project is a trip to Germany in June 2022 with a very small number of choir students to meet again the Wolfratshausen Children's and Youth Choir and a Lithuanian choir.
