FIT 1 / A1-LEVEL CERTIFICATES

In June 2022 some students of year 8 and year 9 passed the FIT 1 A1-level exam at Goethe Institute Cairo. The Goethe-Zertifikat A1: Fit in Deutsch 1 is a German exam for children and young people between 10 and 16 years of age. It certifies that candidates have acquired very basic language skills and corresponds to the first level (A1) on the six-level scale of competence laid down in the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR).
