Read Write Inc.

The children will keep going through and practising sets 1, 2, and 3 of their streaming lessons. They will keep reading the assigned storybooks as they gain fluency in reading.

Reading & Writing

The children will read made-up tales about the north and south poles with a focus on polar adventures. They will research and write about the creatures that inhabit the Arctic and Antarctica.

As they begin writing facts with headings and subheadings, the kids will concentrate on reading both fiction and nonfiction books. Every two weeks, they will also concentrate on the characters, locations, and plot of a narrative.

Grammar

The children will be introduced to new grammar rules:

- Pronouns
- Conjunctions- (using and)
- Plurals
- Determiners (articles- an,a,the)

Also practice more comprehension exercises.

Home Challenges:

Home challenge will be related to the subjects chosen, such as safaris and polar expeditions. To improve the children's vocabulary and knowledge of the stories being told, we'll add comprehension tasks along with spelling and grammar. Worksheets and tasks in math will be provided for them to try at home. In order to test their creativity and find answers to questions related to it, the children will also do projects for science and world studies.

Science

The children will learn about the animals of Africa and their diets, and they'll talk about which animals are herbivores, carnivores, and omnivores. They will look at animal classifications and discover how mammals, amphibians, reptiles, fish, and birds have evolved to survive in harsh climates, exploring the icy poles and the hot Savannah.

World Studies

Children will discover where the polar areas of the Arctic and Antarctica are on the global map throughout the upcoming term. By seeing the Polar Regions, people will be able to comprehend how they seem. They will embark on a "polar trip" by learning about the explorers of the Arctic and Antarctic. Children will get knowledge of the region's climate, weather, and animal inhabitants. We'll talk about how humans have adapted and created houses in the world's coldest regions.

SEAL

Going for Goals: This theme focuses primarily on the key aspect of motivation, with a subsidiary focus on self-awareness. The theme also focuses on the underlying prerequisites for successful goal directed learning and behaviour, for example taking responsibility and building feelings of confidence and self-efficacy - the belief that what you do makes a difference.

Good to be me

This theme is focusing specifically on feelings. It explores feelings in the context of the child as an individual, developing self-awareness and helping the child to realise that it really is 'Good to be me'. The theme is about understanding our feelings as well as considering our strengths and weaknesses as learners.

Maths

Place value

We will focus on using a variety of images to embed an understanding of 2-digit numbers and place value, including finding one more/less.

Number facts

We will focus on embedding a reliable recall of number facts, then using these to solve simple word problems.

Addition and subtraction

We will focus on using known number facts to add and subtract using unit patterns and other strategies.

3D shapes; time

We will focus on naming and identifying 3D shapes and their properties, and then on rehearsing days of the week and months of the year.

Numbers and counting; fractions

We will focus on counting, extending this skill to include counting in 2s, 5s, 10s and identifying patterns; counting is related to estimation and then to halves and quarters as equal parts of a whole.

Art

The children will make crafts linked to the North and South poles, they will learn how to draw and paint animals that live in the Arctic and Antarctic.

ICT

The children will continue learning about kidpix program to know how to do a whole project using all the features of the basics tools within the application.

Music

The children will learn about the dynamics with reference to music using a variety of different percussions and tones.

Physical Education

The children will continue to work on sport games; they will learn the basics of the games. They will learn how to catch and throw the ball following the tennis game rules; also they will learn how to do forehand and backhand.
