

### English

#### Read write Inc

The children have been assigned to their new phonic levels in RWI. They will focus on set 2 and set 3 sounds to enhance more vocabulary and increase their speed in their reading fluency.

#### Reading & Writing

The children will start to write in cursive writing and practice more and more scrambled sentences. The children will revisit punctuation and use their common exception words to structure.

The children will be introduced to new grammar rules:

- Articles- 'a' and 'an'
- Suffixes- ing/ed/er/est

Also practice more comprehension exercises.

#### Home Challenges:

Home challenge will be related to the subjects chosen, Explorers and adventures. To improve the children's vocabulary and knowledge of the stories being told, we'll add comprehension tasks along with spelling and grammar. Worksheets and tasks in math will be provided for them to try at home. In order to test their creativity and find answers to questions related to it, the children will also do projects for science and world studies.

### Science

The children will learn all about sea life and explore the world under the sea. They will discover the names of sea creatures and learn about the selector structure, are they vertebrates or invertebrates. They will also look at the effects of pollution and plastic and how it affects the sea world. They will understand how dangerous rubbish waste is affecting the sea world.

### World Studies

Children will learn all about Christopher Columbus and how he discovered the Atlantic Ocean and went on a voyage with ships and crew men. They will learn about his history and look at a timeline to learn what he had accomplished and what he discovered along the way. The children will also look at different physical characteristics of the world's geography including: beach, cliff, coast, forest, hill, mountain, sea, ocean, river, soil, valley, vegetation.

### SEAL

'Relationships': This theme explores feelings within the context of our important relationships including family and friends.

All the above themes aim to develop knowledge, understanding and skills in three key social and emotional aspects of learning: self-awareness, managing feelings and empathy.

### Maths

#### Addition and subtraction

Focus on addition and subtraction, specifically in relation to counting on and back, sometimes crossing 10.

#### Place value and money

Focus on place value in 2-digit numbers and then in relation to money: £1s, 10s, 1ps; children find 1 / 10 more / less than any number.

#### Place value

Focus on consolidating understanding of 2-digit numbers, representing these in different ways, and partitioning into 10s and 1s.

#### Addition and subtraction

Focus on the revision of number facts and using these to solve additions and subtractions involving 1- and 2-digit numbers.

### Art

The children will make crafts linked to pirates and adventure themes. They will also make a Ramadan craft to celebrate the holy month.

### ICT

The children will continue learning about the kidpix program to know how to do a whole project using all the features of the basics tools within the application.

### Music

The children will learn about the dynamics with reference to music using a variety of different percussions and tones.

### Physical Education

The children will continue to work on sport games; they will learn the basics of basketball. They will learn how to pass and dribble the ball following the game rules.
