Key Stage 2 Department Autumn (2) Curriculum Overview Year 3-Autumn 2 Term – 2022/2023

English

English topics that were covered in Autumn 2 term are as follows:

- -In weeks one and two of this unit students studied a playscript, A Tune of Lies by Lou Kuenzler. In the reading week, the focus is on developing children's enjoyment of plays, exploring key themes. In the writing week, the students were more familiar with the conventions of the script form, leading up to writing their own episodes.
- -The Non-fiction week continues the link of Science topic with a focus on instruction texts about how to plant a seed.
- -Where appropriate, the students were encouraged to develop an awareness of audience and purpose in relation to the fiction and non-fiction tests they are reading and writing.

Maths

Maths in Autumn 2 term ensured consolidating knowledge learnt in Autumn 1 to allow children to build on new mathematical skills. Maths topics that were covered in Autumn 2 term are as follows:

- Place value 2 and 3 digits numbers on a number line.
- Identify, represent and estimate numbers using different representations.
- Solve word problems using place value.
- Recap times-tables learned and derive division facts.

Science

Science topic that was covered in Autumn 2 term is as follows:

Rocks:

- •Students were able to learn about how to differentiate rocks according to its texture, hardness, colour and permeability.
- •They carried out some tests to compare rocks and learn about the three different types of rocks e.g. metamorphic, igneous and sedimentary rocks.
- •They also recognised that soil comes from rock and learnt how fossil are formed.

SEAL

The children had the opportunity to identify types of bullying and recognise its symptoms. They were able to observe the effect of our actions have on others, they learnt to care about other people's feelings and to try to see things from their points of view. They gained knowledge about using problem solving skills to generate solutions and decide on a course of action.

World Studies

World Studies topic that was covered in Autumn 2 term is as follows:

Geography: Life in the village and the view from my window

Students examined scales used in maps and the symbols used to indicate the various features. They learnt that a city, town and village differ not only in size but also in the buildings and employment opportunities they have. They explored some of the effects of the growing human population on the environment and on plant and animal species.

Global Perspective

In Autumn 2 term, students were able to listen to others in class discussions and respond with relevant ideas. They learnt how to communicate by Choosing the right words when sharing a message with our community. They learnt to develop empathy and gratitude when listening to other people's perspectives.

Art

In Autumn 2 term, students were able to understand how to use watercolour. They also learnt how to use oil pastel and how to mix the colours together. They learnt how to draw Santa Claus, snowmen and Christmas trees.

Music

In Autumn 2 term, students worked on time signature 2/4, dynamics, music notation and creating music.

<u>ICT</u>

In Autumn 2 term, students Students were able to create a folder, search on Google. Also they learnt how to save images and information from the internet. They learnt to copy information and paste it.

Physical Education

In Autumn 2 term, students were able to perform the basic one handed Dribble while running. They execute the 3 basic passes: Bounce, chest and overhead. They learnt to shoot at the basket using correct shooting technique. They played a competitive match using teamwork to incorporate objectives 1 and 2 and 3.

<u>MFL</u>

French:

In Autumn 2 term, we students learnt about school supplies, the activity of the free time, the adjectives and the opposite. They were able to write sentences in French using I like and I don't like. They learnt "verbe avoir and verbe etre" only singular part. They identified adjectives and the part of the face and they learnt how to describe themselves and others. Students finished till page 4 in the story "Une pizza parfaite"

German: Unite 3: (Oh dear, oh dear, my head hurts)which included: asking about health, name body parts. They were able to describe the condition and name complaints and describe diseases. Students were able to express health tips and recommendations.
