



Key Stage 2 Department Spring (2) Curriculum Overview Year 4-Spring 2 Term – 2022/2023

English

English topics that were covered in Spring 2 term are as follows:

In this unit, children read the story “Sugarcane Juice”. They explore the setting and characters in the story. The students planned a new episode focusing on the build up, dilemma, resolution and ending. In the non-fiction section focuses on persuasive writing and how to convince the reader to watch the film “Hamid’s adventure” by creating posters. They wrote a letter to convince their friends to watch the film and they were able to understand the features of writing a persuasive letters.

Maths

Maths in Spring 2 term ensured that the students were exposed to different aspects of Maths. The Spring term 2 topics were:

- Written multiplication and division
- Fractions, ratio and proportion
- Geometry: properties of shapes
- Measurement

Science

Science topic that was covered in Spring 2 term is:

Changes of states–

In this topic children learnt about states of matter. They compared and grouped materials together, according to whether they are solids, liquids or gases. They observed that some materials change state when heated or cooled, and they were able to identify the part played by evaporation and condensation in the water cycle.

SEAL

The children had the opportunity to recognise their worth as individuals, by identifying positive things about themselves and their achievements, seeing their mistakes, making amends and setting personal goals. They learnt that their actions affect themselves and others, to care about other people’s feelings and to try to see things from their points of view. They were able to talk and write about their opinions, and explain their views, on issues that affect themselves and society.

World Studies

World Studies topic that was covered in Spring 2 term is :

Geography : What’s in the News and Life in India –The students explored the physical, human and environmental features of India. India is the seventh largest country in the world in terms of area. It is home to a vast diversity of landscapes, climate, culture, language and ethnicity. In spite of its rapid economic growth and burgeoning high-tech industries.

In Spring 2 term, students have been learning:
Communicating information

In Spring 2 term, students have been learning: -

- Students were able to define and explain the difference between Tints&Shades.
- Learnt about colour mixing by using Paint and how to get the Tints&Shades.

In Spring 2 term, students have been learning:

- Electronic instrument
- Dynamics review
- Indonesian Music

MFL

French:

Unit 5 :

“En ville avec Manon et Juliette” learning the different places in the town in French and the numbers from 20 to 70 in French and how to ask about prices in the supermarket. We will take the grammar (the verbs “ to go” third group)

Story : “Le renard et les raisins” and do the comprehension about it.

German:

In Spring 2 term, students have been learning:
Chapter 4 my friends.

- Pupils can talk about meeting places.

ICT

This half term progresses learners’ knowledge and understanding of data and how it can be collected over time to answer questions. The unit also introduces the idea of automatic data collection. Learners are also introduced to data in tables and graphs.

Physical Education

In Spring 2 term, students have been learning:

To Swim Front crawl with basic technique for 1 width of the 25M pool and recognise and recall the names of the 4 swimming strokes.
